Description

This optional one-day add-on course can be booked together with the ULD Build-Up Initial Course or the ULD Build-Up Refresher Course. It introduces participants to airline-specific operational procedures based on the Lufthansa Cargo Build-Up Manual (BUP) and complements the general regulatory training provided in the core ULD build-up programs.

The training provides a structured overview of the operational rules and procedures defined in the Lufthansa Cargo BUP documentation. Participants learn how airline-specific requirements interact with the general regulatory framework defined by IATA ULD Regulations (ULDR), ICAO Weight & Balance requirements, and airline operational procedures. The course explains the responsibilities of shippers, freight forwarders, and ground handling agents when preparing ULDs for airline operations and highlights the operational standards expected for cargo restraint, contour compliance, and documentation. Through practical examples and operational scenarios, participants gain valuable insight into the processes used when preparing ULDs according to airline-specific build-up procedures.

The course content is based on operational guidance from the Lufthansa Cargo Build-Up Manual (BUP) and provides insight into airline-specific build-up procedures and operational standards. Upon completion, participants receive an AviationNOW certificate of completion. This course is delivered independently and does not provide Lufthansa Cargo certification.

- Understanding how airline build-up standards influence safety, efficiency, and cargo acceptance.
