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Description

Particular emphasis is placed on air cargo operations, warehousing, packaging, CMR and multimodal transport, transport documentation, AWBs, customs procedures, Incoterms® 2020, HS Codes, origin and preferential trade, as well as export control and compliance. In addition, participants learn how to better understand air freight, shipping and customs costs, analyze transport invoices and cost structures, efficiently plan bookings and capacity, and confidently manage the typical challenges of international shipping. Practical examples, document exercises and international case studies provide a direct connection to everyday business operations and equip participants with valuable know-how for the safe, compliant and cost-effective handling of international air cargo shipments.
